

St Charles Borromeo Church Grounds - Required Tree Surgery

The following information was provided by a Tree Surgeon, Mr Ben Tebby of Ben Tebby Tree Services, The Ashes, Haseley Knob, Warwick, CV35 7NJ, following visit to site on 28th March 2022.

Ref	Tree / Requirement Specification, including Ben's recommendations
T1	Holly (split): As Spec'd - take to ground
T2	Acacia cluster: Deadwood and shorten back branches overhanging road
T3 (TPO)	Acacia: Deadwood and shorten back branches overhanging road (TPO Ref W20 - R6 T3)
T4	Holly x2: As spec'd - approx. 10 feet (30%) reduction & trim to shape
T5	Holly: As spec'd - approx. 10 feet (30%) reduction & trim to shape
T6	Yew: As spec'd - approx. 10-15 feet (20-30%) reduction & shape; crown lift removing low hanging branches
T7	Silver Birch: Fell, due to excessive rot in the base of the trunk
T8	Yew: Cut back overhanging branches away from neighbours
T9	Acacia: Remove lowest limb to the union, deadwood and lift
T10	Silver Birch: Light thin
T11	Ash: Approx. 20 feet (30%) reduction & shape
T12 (TPO)	Horse Chestnut: Cut back roadside overhanging branches by approx. 2-3m (TPO Ref W20 - R6 T1)
