**Description of Works - Reduce the size of two chimney stacks to make safe

Reason for works

The chimneys were unsafe, they were an accident waiting to happen. We have sent photographs to prove this, and the gales that were predicted arrived just as bad as imagined. The potential for a serious accident or death made this a health and safety issue, so we did the work necessary to make them safe.

First floor sash glazing bars. Deep wooden modillion eaves C1820. Hipped roof, off-centre stack. First floor return (E) 2 casements with glazing bars, 2 lights each, C20 flat-roofed extension below.
