Classification as per Table 1 cascade chart of British Standard 5837 (2012) Trees in relation to design, demolition and construction - Recommended -

Canopy of Category B trees -
Trees of moderate quality with an estimated life expectancy of at least 20 years

Canopy of Category C trees -
Trees of low quality with an estimated life expectancy of at least 10 years, or young trees with a stem diameter of below 150mm
