Management Plan – 309 St. Anne’s Road, Blackpool, FY4 2EE

Home Operations Structure.

There will always be 2 staff on shift supported by the home manager, who are also on call for the home when they are not in the children’s home.

Coastal Care Children’s Home structure is as follows:

- One home manager who is registered with Ofsted
- 3 lead practitioners qualified to level 3 and above who run the shifts daily
- 3 practitioners who support the running of the shift and work towards level 3
- 2 night practitioners

Clarification of Home Operation 309 St. Anne’s Road, Blackpool. FY4 2EE

The home will accommodate two children in need of care from the Blackpool Borough. During the day there will be 2 staff in attendance in addition to the home manager.

There will be three shifts of two persons, and the manager will be present during normal working hours.

It is anticipated that the shifts will change at 8AM & 11PM, and overnight there will be two members of staff present, both on ‘staff sleeping’ support will be there if required to the individual child.

In total there will be 7 employees directly associated with the operation of this Coastal Care Children’s Home.

There will be a variety of children with various needs from the Blackpool Area, there will be no particular concentration on complex needs. The therapeutic services will be available if required to the individual child's needs, however we don't facilitate an in house therapist.

Ofsted Registration

Clifton House by Coastal Care Group will be Ofsted Registered.

General Matters

Children will be able to leave the property, but staff members will have to be informed and would, as a matter of course, be aware if the child had left the property.

No Children will be left alone at the property.

There will be no curfew, all our children will be treated as they would be in a family home. For example, children will be expected to attend meal times and go to bed in the normal way & time. Bed timings will depend on the age of the child.

Depending on the care plan of the child, if allowed to see family or relatives this can be supported within the home under supervision at all times.

Home security of the home will be as of a normal dwelling house. There will not be access controlled doors and CCTV will not be installed.

It would not be appropriate to display the contact details of the company outside the property.

In the event of an issue arising it will need to be taken up with the home manager or the general management of the company by contacting Coastal Care Group's Head Office.

Education/Therapy

90% of children will be attending full time education from the beginning, as all children will be from the Blackpool Area, most children will already be in attendance to a local school.

If not attending school we would progress our children to full-time education as normal.

All Staff will be therapeutically trained and consequently there is an element of therapy at all times, but as stated above additional therapy support will be available to the child's needs.
