Flint construction with stone quoins. Combination of red brick, stone and tiled plinth capped with stone



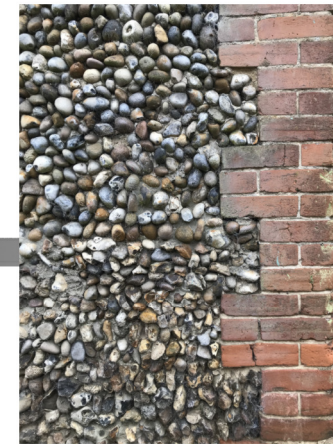
The Old Rectory

Flint construction with red brick quoins and gothic brick arches

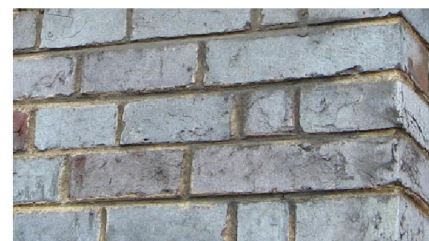


Gate Lodge - (originally gatehouse to The Old Rectory)

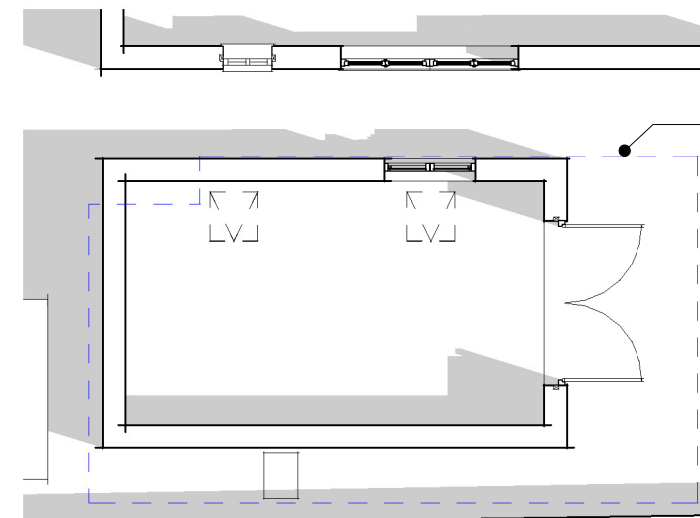

Handmade soft red bricks and lime mortar

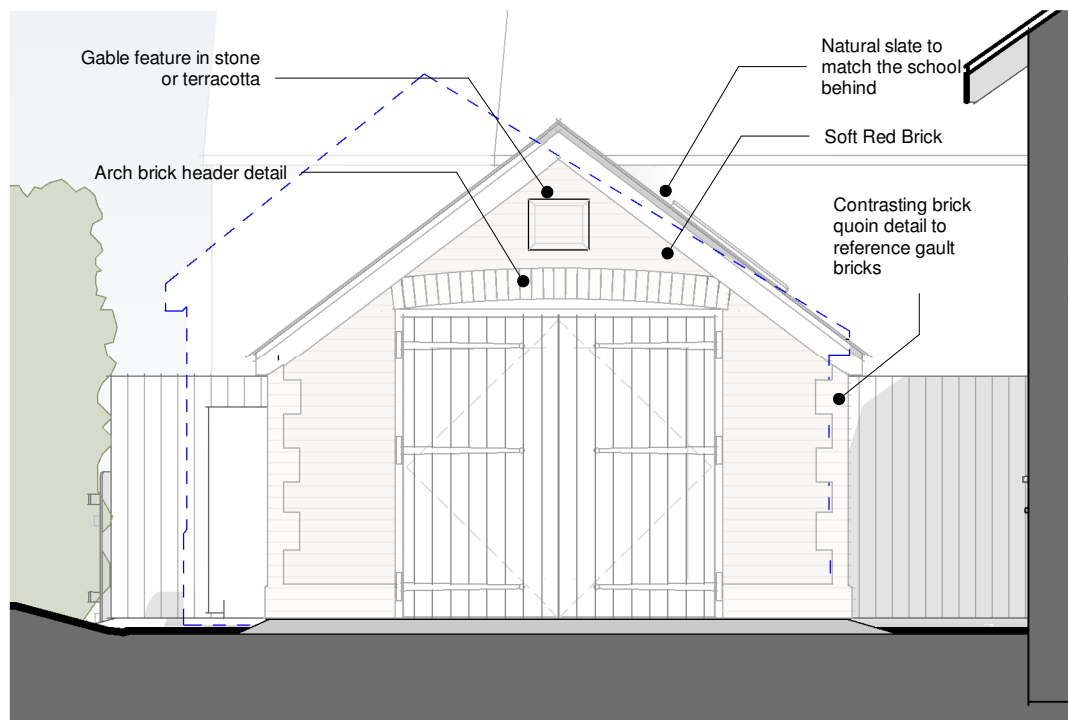
