

# Leylandii Removal at Warningcamp Farm

## Background:

- Walnut Tree (under REF No 3/28/91 (TPO) / TPO/W/1/85) is being constricted by a Leylandii hedge that has grown out of control over ten years.
- The leylandii hedge is not on the boundary of the property. There is a clear definition between the leylandii hedging and the cattle fencing behind.
- The land is adjacent to Warningcamp Farmhouse but is not in the listed curtilage as there is a road dividing it from the Farmhouse gardens.

## Proposal:

- Removal of the leylandii hedging in its entirety.
- Care and consideration for the Walnut Tree (under TPO) during the removal of the Leylandii to include:
  - Protection from falling branches
  - No chemicals or burning of existing stumps
  - Minimal disruption to the feeder roots at 600mm below soil level
  - Minimal grinding of stumps below turf level
- Once removed, replacement of the Leylandii with a traditional mixed english native hedge that will be maintained to 1800mm from turf level.
