RE: Condition 04 Application of 71 Carlton Hill (ref: 20/01191/FULL)

I am writing to apply for partial discharge of planning condition 04 which reads as follows:

'You must apply to us for approval of the brickwork shown in context with the existing brickwork of the facing materials you will use, including glazing, and elevations and roof plans annotated to show where the materials are to be located. You must not start work on the relevant part of the development until we have approved in writing what you have sent us. You must then carry out the work using the approved materials. (C26BD)'

Please find included with this submission annotated images of the proposed brick panel to be used on the rebuilding of the flank and rear external walls. The main contractor has erected a sample panel on site, should you wish to review this in person.
