- 1. The reason for the lights is so the horses can be exercised in the evenings after work all year round to keep the horses fit and healthy.
- 2. This is to be used for our personal use and is not for profit.
- 3. Maximum of 8 lights and a minimum of 6 lights so as not to cause any shadows on the arena which could cause the hose to 'Spook', which is dangerous to the horse and the rider.
- 4. The height of the lights will be no more than 3.6 metres high.
- 5. The flood light to be used are LED, so environmentally friendly, minimum heat output.
- 6. The power of each flood LED light with be approx. equivalent to 150 watts each.
- 7. The lights will have an isolation switch next to the arena in case of emergency and to turn on/off the lights.
- 8. The light circuit will be protected from a consumer box, with RCA protection.
- The lights will not affect the nearby road (which is approx. 30 metres away) as it is behind our out houses and mature hedge.
- 10. The nearby neighbours won't be affected either as there are two hedges in between the neighbours (who are over 50 metres away) and the arena.
