Proposed permanent front canopy to The Bolt Hole, Falconwood Parade, Welling.


INTRODUCTION

SITE OVERVIEW AND CONTEXT

The site is part of a parade of shops on Falconwood Parade, located between The Green and Cambridge Avenue. There are a variety of shops along the parade all with rear access via a shared track.




DESIGN PROPOSALS

This application proposes a permanent aluminium pergola to the front of the building, 5.4 m x 3.5 m in size, with a retractable roof and sides.

The purpose of this front canopy, would be to provide adequate shelter for customers of the Bolthole Micropub in all weather. The retractable roof and sides allows the proposed area of pavement to be accessible to the public when the Bolthole Micropub is closed.

Our client currently has pavement permission for a gazebo, and has also received an email from Mark Rigby, of the London Borough of Bexley Street Scene Services, stating that he has no objections with this proposal.





CONCLUSION

The Application seeks planning approval for a front canopy at The Bolthole Micropub, 12 Falconwood Parade, Welling.
