Proposed Slurry Store at East Ash Farm

In line with government guidance, the applicant requires additional storage to meet the needs of the current regulations which state dairy farms should aim to have at least 6 months storage.

Their existing storage is not sufficient and therefore an additional store is required.

The proposal will be dug into the ground with concrete walls and floor; the concrete panels will protrude the ground by approx. 300mm.

Given the proposed location is within in close proximity of a SSSI, a SCAIL assessment has been carried out demonstrating that by covering both the existing store and the new store there is a net reduction (Column L in the accompanying report) in the emissions compared to the current situation. The new store will lead to increased storage, reduced emissions, reduced diffuse pollution, reduced soil erosion and greater nutrient recycling.
