Photos to show drop kerb. Concrete splay entrance with drainage at path side.

The drop kerb is tarmac as per Suffolk highways criteria.

Splay entrance is 100mm thick concrete slab with reinforcing mesh. The distance from road to concrete edge is 5m

The rest of the driveway is simply made up of 100-125mm of crushed concrete mixed in with road plannings which is laid onto dirt.

the final layer is 20-50mm thick of 20mm stone on top with timber borders.

Please let me know if this is sufficient or anymore information is needed.
