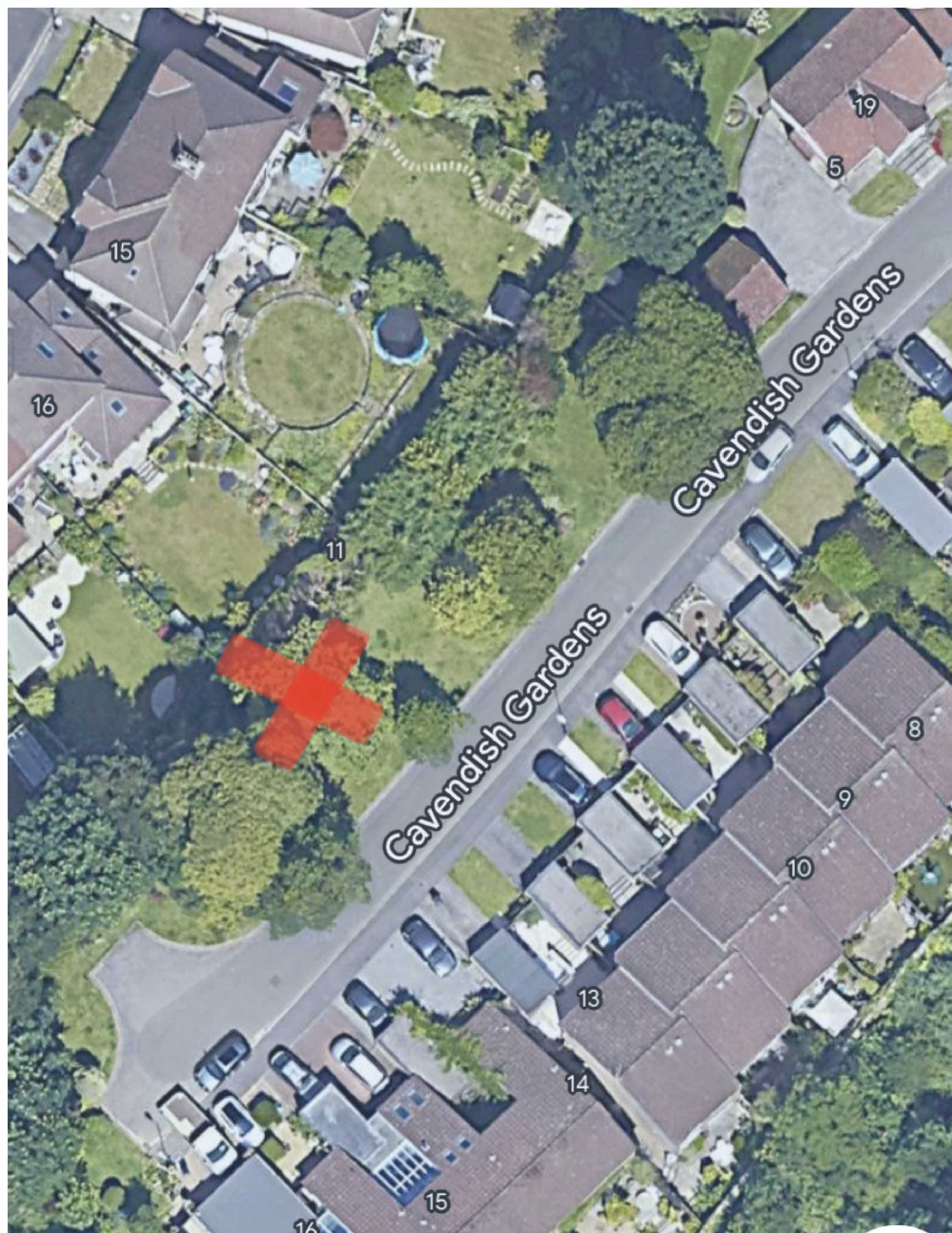
Sweet Chestnut (marked with a red cross on the attached image)

Reason: the tree has died, there is significant decay about the base and extensive colonisation of mycelium (suspected Honey Fungus species) under much of the dead and peeling bark (see images below)
