Dear Liz

I have been forwarded your application to carry out works to trees at Kings Meadow Court, Lydney. It appears that at least one of the trees is covered by a Tree Preservation Order. This would be the Alder that is Item No; 3 on the Quote Information that was submitted with the application form, which is covered by tree preservation order number DFTPO157 (T1 - Alder). The work description for the Alder (Item No. 3), states "Reduce stem as per photograph and lift low growth over garden to 3m". although no photograph has been provide with the application. In order to validate the application it is vital that the description of proposed work is clearly specified, and I would be most grateful if you could specify by how much the stem of this tree is to be reduced by (in metres), and to also submit the photograph that is referred to.

Item No's 1 and 2 on the Quote Information may also be covered by the same Tree Preservation Order, although it is not possible to tell as they are both described as a mixed group. They look to be in close proximity to the locations of T2 (Goat Willow) and T3 (Crack Willow) of DFTPO157. I would be most grateful if you could confirm if any of the trees in these groups match this description. If they do and are considered to be covered by the TPO, they too will require a clearly specified description of works. As at present the work descriptions do not specify the extent of pruning for Item No; 1 and how high the low growth of the trees in Item No. 2 will be lifted by.

I hope you are able to provide me with the information I have requested so that I can validate your application. I look forward to hearing from you.
