Description

A mid 19th century school built in the educational gothic style. The school building is of red brick laid in English bond with a splayed blue brick plinth course with shaped barge boards to the gables and a spire with compass weather vane. The original building was T-shaped on plan, with gable ends forming the termination of each end of the T. Its principal elevation consists of three distinct sections, the central section of which has a gable end with a projecting canted bay window and a spire / bellcote projecting above this. The other two sections are set back from this and are identical to each other, with each having two flat headed lights and a gabled dormer projecting from the tiled roof above. Each of the other gable ends has a flat headed window and a small rectangular light at attic level. The original building has sympathetic early 21st-century extensions to the rear and the original windows have recently been replaced by sympathetic wooden framed windows of a sensitive style. The interior has suspended ceilings and parquet floors. The building has a date stone reading '1856'. (LH, 23-Jan-2008) <1>
