If at any point when completing the form you suspect there is a likelihood that contamination may exist on the site (or on an adjacent site) which could affect the proposed use, it is strongly advised that you contact the Council's Contaminated Land Officer before proceeding, as your findings may necessitate the submission of a more detailed Phase 1 Report.

SITE DESCRIPTION

Within the 'main' shed there is a car awaiting restoration along with various spares / tools etc. There is a derelict caravan on site. The dwelling is served by mains foul drain and surface water is taken to soakaway. There is an underground mains water supply and overhead electricity supply. No evidence was found of any particular 'waste storage' having occurred on site. The remains of a small 'domestic' bonfire were evident. Verbal enquiry and record search reveal no evidence of any quarrying or land fill activity in the vicinity of the site. The entire site is to be comprehensively cleared for the proposed development.
