

ALTERATIONS TO STABLES BUILDING WELL HILL DUNTISBOURNE ABBOTS GL77JN
SITE PHOTOGRAPHS



1. View of vacant stables building from north facing entry forecourt showing random rubble stone walled structure with corrugated iron pitched roof and recessed access to timber fronted stables; Note: Proposal to renovate building including replacing roof with reconstituted stone tiles; part conversion of building into one bedroom flat and remainder into small office with general storage

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2. Close up view of stables building from entry forecourt showing part of front facade with access dormer originally used for delivery of feed to roof space on first floor; timber beams and horizontal boarding above ground floor recessed access; Note: Proposal to reconstruct dormer in timber incorporating fully glazed window to provide additional view, light and ventilation to living accommodation of one bedroom flat

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3. View of east facade of stables building showing stone gabled facade and lower screen wall to small yard; building to right behind is adjacent Audley House (see drawing 2 Block Plans for context); Note: Proposal to raise height of yard wall with new flat roof to form ground floor utility and first floor terrace to living space with conversion of window into glazed timber framed doors for access to steel balustraded terrace

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4. View of south facade of stables building showing varied window openings including blocked up large opening to left; site boundary with concrete wall extends towards front of image to retain raised ground level of adjacent Audley House property; Note: Proposal to construct stone wall to landscaped courtyard at south facade to provide private amenity for one bedroomed flat and separation from remainder of farm yard; also replacement of steel windows with new timber windows and glazed doors (see drawings 1 to 6)
