The original dwelling known as 'The Lawsons' was built during the 1950's. Planning permission was granted in 2007 for substantial extensions to the property, which would have completely remodelled the house. However, at that time the landowner decided that it would be more economical to knock down the original property and completely re-built it as a new dwelling. The building works and occupation of the new dwelling were completed in 2007 (more than 10 year ago) and the new dwelling has been occupied continuously as such since that time. The exterior of the new built property appears similar to that granted as part of the 2007 permission, but the internal layout is completely different.

This application is accompanied by sufficient evidence to show the property was rebuilt and not extended in 2007. See submitted Planning Statement for further information.
