The planning condition requires a walking bus scheme to be submitted prior to commencement of the development and we have placed a caveat in the document to allow flexibility following your consultation with parents. Its not possible at this stage to expect that all detail for the scheme is known however the broad outline of how the condition will be delivered has been set out. If there are minor amendments to this, to accommodate the staggered start and finish times, for example, to make the bus a success and fit in with the other wider school practices then we can address these with planning at that stage if necessary.
