The line of trees is identified in the attached plan, highlighted by a red line. The beech trees were originally planted as a hedge and have, over the past years, become overgrown to full trees. The trees are tightly spaced as is the norm for hedge planting.
The works planned are to crown reduce to approximately 4 metres high, and to prune back to the boundary line.
The trees are situated with the Ledsham Conservation Area, and are adjacent to Claypit Lane, Ledsham.
You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
