

Bugdon House – 5 Bridge Street – Loddon
Heritage Statement (incorporating D&A)

Bugdon House is a listed building in Loddon conservation area. The listing states:

LODDON BRIDGE STREET TM 3698 (west side)

10/40 No. 5 (Bugdon House) 25-9-51 (Formerly listed as House occupied by Mrs. E. Ward and under High Street)

GV II

House, early C18. Red brick. Steep black glazed pantile roof with coped gable ends. Two storeys. Six windows (two on each floor blocked). Two-light wood mullion/transom casements; first floor right modern. Off-centre right pilastered doorcase with open pediment, semi-circular fanlight with radial bars and fielded panel door. String course at floor level rises over doorway and brick corner pilasters. At rear, wing, late medieval or C16 timber frame encased in early C18 red brick, with steep pantile roof with coped gable end, two storeys and attic. Brick chimney stacks.

Listing NGR: TM3615398784

This application seek permission to build a detached garage/workshop in the rear garden accessed from George Lane. There is existing parking and access with a brick wall fronting the road. It is proposed to build a modest brick and tile building tucked in behind the wall. Red brick, pantiled roof and painted external joinery are proposed
