T1 Sycamore Work: Remove low 6" limb above garden to raise canopy. Shorten minor branches as required to balance with above branch removal. Shorten internal Sucker growth over property. The Tree is located on the boundary of multiple gardens, it is very large for the location having significant impact on light. The tree will continue to increase in size, so management will aid in reducing conflict with garden use and tree development. You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
