Aim? Improve aesthetics of front area

① (Holly) L - side Pathway

Remove Low water shoots etc. ("Possibly" remove tree if view of the church entrance is required).

② (Oak.) R - Side pathway.

remove 3-4 lowest branches to clear walkway

allow light and show more of the doorway from the road - pathway. (remove deadwood)

③ (Holly) R - side nearest door.

My recommendation would be to remove this tree!

(stopping the growth of the beautiful multi-stemmed Yew)

(blocking light and the view of the Yew !!)

which will recover.

the minimum would be to remove the large un natural growth.

④ (Holly) twin stem. (almost dead!) remove.

⑤ (Ash) @ front remove small dead branches + One dead stem

⑥ (Oak) leaning by front side

(Sympathetic) removal of a few of the over hanging branches
weight reduction will lift the branch slightly.

(remove deadwood)
