The tree we wish to remove is in, or about 'what three words' position: raves.hours.outfitter  Note that this position is on the opposite bank (left bank) from the post code already given. It is easiest to view the tree from our, Westaways, bank (right bank)

We have marked the tree with some red electrical tape which should be visible from our bank.

I will include a photograph of the tree to assist identification.

I will also include photographs of the narrow section of the river that has caused upstream flooding during high water events.

## Identification of Tree(s) and Description of Works

Please identify the tree(s) and provide a full and clear specification of the works you want to carry out

The tree has been identified as being a lime tree by our tree surgeon.

We need it removed completely, including its rootball in order to a) allow greater flow of water through the river narrows during high water events to prevent reoccurrence of severe upstream flooding that has caused significant damage to residential property. And b) to facilitate removal of sediment in which the tree stands in order to slightly widen the river to help prevent the aforementioned flooding.

Note that there is some hazel growth in the same sediment that will also require pruning back, but this is of very limited size, less than 5cm diameter.

Replacement trees have already been planted on the right bank, including willows, silver birch, Rowans and blackthorn. Other native trees will be planted this year.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
