### *Acer palmatum* 'Inaba-shidare' (Japanese maple 'Inaba-shidare')

Quantity: 1

Pot size: None

'Inaba-shidare' is a compact yet vigorous, arching, deciduous shrub with finely divided, dark purple leaves turning crimson in autumn. Small, purple flowers in spring are followed by winged fruit.

### *Betula pendula* 'Purpurea' (Purple birch)

Quantity: 1

Pot size: None

'Purpurea' is a slender, slow-growing, deciduous tree, upright when young and weeping with age, with bronze-purple leaves and silver-grey bark.

### *Betula utilis* var. *jacquemontii* (West Himalayan birch)

Quantity: 1

Pot size: None

*B. utilis* var. *jacquemontii* is a variable, deciduous tree with peeling, white bark, ovate to oblong, tapered, glossy dark green leaves which turn yellow in autumn and yellow-brown male catkins in early spring.

### *Buxus sempervirens* 'Suffruticosa' (Box 'Suffruticosa')

Quantity: 1

Pot size: None

'Suffruticosa' is a small, evergreen shrub with shiny dark-green leaves. It bears insignificant pale-yellow flowers.

### *Carpinus caroliniana* (American hornbeam)

Quantity: 1

Pot size: None

*C. caroliniana* is a spreading, deciduous tree with ovate, sharply-toothed, blue-green leaves turning yellow to orange-red in autumn. Yellow male catkins and green female catkins in late winter or early spring are followed by racemes of winged, green fruit ripening yellow-brown.

### *Fagus sylvatica* (Common beech)

Quantity: 1

Pot size: None

*F. sylvatica* is a large and fast-growing deciduous tree with a broad, spreading crown; elliptic, yellow-green leaves in spring, turning rich russet-brown in autumn; and small, green flowers, followed by bristly fruits.

### Ligustrum ovalifolium 'Aureum' (Golden privet)

Quantity: 1

Pot size: None

'Aureum' is an upright, dense, evergreen shrub bearing ovate, glossy, mid-green leaves with broad, irregular, yellow margins and, in spring or summer, small panicles of creamy-white flowers, occasionally followed by small black fruit.

### Malus 'Royal Beauty' (Weeping crab apple)

Quantity: 1

Pot size: None

'Royal Beauty' is a narrow spreading, deciduous tree with a weeping habit. It has reddish-bronze foliage with very deep pink flowers in the spring. Dark red apples appear in the fall.

### Photinia x fraseri 'Red Robin' (Christmas berry 'Red Robin')

Quantity: 1

Pot size: None

P. x fraseri 'Red Robin' is an evergreen shrub with red leaves that turn green as they mature. Panicles of creamy-white flowers are produced in spring.

### Prunus padus (Bird cherry)

Pot size: None

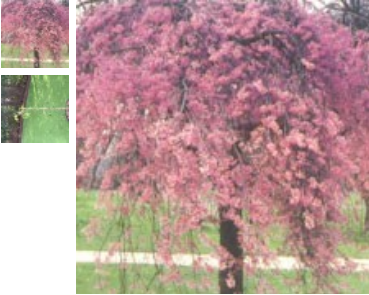
P. padus is a spreading, deciduous tree or shrub with elliptic, toothed, dark green leaves turning yellow or red in autumn and pendent racemes of cup-shaped, white flowers in spring followed by glossy, spherical, blue-black fruit.
