<u>Proposed Works by Advanced Joinery Overview</u>

Advanced Joinery has been approached by Mr Mrs John Keki, Nutmeg Cottage, Thwaite Common, Empingham, Norfolk, who are the owners regarding replacement of the windows and entrance door. After a close inspection, we ascertained that the existing windows were in a mismatch of different designs none of which would be considered as a window of historic importance, this was also confirmed by Mr Christ Young from North Norfolk District Council in his letter regarding listed building advise, 1st July 2022.

We are proposing to replace the existing windows with new traditional hardwood recessed casement design installed with slimline thin sealed units. The ironmongery would be a sympathetic black curly tail design.
