One conifer tree which is either a Thuja or Cupressus and is at the North Lane end of the property on the west side of the rear gates. There are sheds to the east and north of the tree. The lower branches extend three metres or so over the boundary with 29 Castle Street. The plan is to clear fell the tree and remove the debris from the site. As there is a Sycamore tree to the east of this tree and a mature apple tree to the Immediate south and further trees and large shrubs in the garden there is no wish to plant another tree at present.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
