T1 Oak (Tag No:0295) - Remove to ground level due to ganerderma brackets and other fungus present at base. The tree is situated on the tent pitch area close to the out buildings.

T2 Oak (Tag No:0197) - Reduce in height by up-to 5m, bringing the height from 14m to 9m. This is to remove the large wound / cavity at the top of the tree as it has lost two thirds of the heart wood and the cavity reaches through to the other side of the stem. The rest of the canopy is to be reduced by up to 3m bringing the crown spread from 11m to 5m. This is to reduce the sail preventing a limb failure and allow the tree to recover at the same rate as the top. The tree is situated beside the tennis court.

T3 Silver Birch (Tag No:0159) - remove to ground level, this is due to concerns of the lean of the tree and the roots exposed of the ditch line.

T4 Oak - remove to ground level due to large cavity at base of tree.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
