

Tree 6

Tree 6. Although this Mature Horse Chestnut has its roots in the neighbouring property (St Pauls) It has overgrown the churchyard and it's fruits when heavy are causing concern to families with memorials inside the churchyard. With permission from the occupant of St Pauls , we would envisage reducing all overhanging branches, so to reduce the nuisance being caused!

Tree 5

Tree 5 is a medium age Cherry Tree. It has been left to get out of shape and the length of some of its outer branches are becoming detrimental to the tree and causing some concern to members of the public when attending their memorials that are beneath the tree.

After consulting with a local Arborist, we recommend that reducing the length of the branches affected, by approx 1.5 -2 Mt's , which will stabilise the growth and shape of the whole tree and will ensure its longevity!

Tree 4

Tree 4 is a young Yew tree in need of Crown reduction. It has been left too long without attention and is encroaching on its neighbouring trees. After consultation with a local Arborist, we recommend a height reduction of some 2 Mts and a reduction of the diameter to suit the shape of the tree!

The overall effect will be ,to enhance the appearance of the churchyard and to promote the future health and longevity of each individual tree!

Tree 3

Tree 3, is a young Yew tree in need of Crown reduction. It has been left too long without attention and is encroaching on its neighbouring trees. After consultation with a local Arborist, we recommend a height reduction of some 2 Mts

and a reduction of the diameter, to suit the shape of the tree!

The overall effect will be ,to enhance the appearance of the churchyard and to promote the future health and longevity of each individual tree!

Tree 2

Tree 2 is a young Yew tree in need of Crown reduction. It has been left too long without attention and is encroaching on its neighbouring trees. After consultation with a local Arborist, we recommend a height reduction of some 2 Mts and a reduction of the diameter to suit the shape of the tree!

The overall effect will be ,to enhance the appearance of the churchyard and to promote the future health and longevity of each individual tree!

Tree 1

Tree 1 is a young Yew tree in need of Crown reduction. It is set very close to the Church building. It has been left too long without attention and is shedding excess water onto the stonework , causing some mould to grow on the North face of the Church, which , if left to continue have a detrimental effect on the

stone fabric!

After consultation with a local Arborist, we recommend a height reduction of some 2 Mts and a reduction of the diameter to suit the shape of the tree! This will reduce the adverse effect on the Church itself.

The overall effect will be to enhance the appearance of the churchyard and to promote the future health and longevity of each individual tree!
