Anne,

With reference to our correspondence 23/9/2022

Please note that after conversations with our roofer, he has recommended that we do not install roof vents as originally proposed in our application as he does not advise that we cut into the corrugated sheets. **Therefore we are no longer proposing to install any additional venting to the roof**

This means that we are only asking for LBC to replace the existing roof covering in order to make the building watertight.

I am sending in addition to this email a series of emails with the annotated photographs listed below to show proposed changes. We are not proposing to change any of the guttering or down pipes as they are sound. We are solely looking to replace the corrugated sheets.
