Thank you for the door details. As the building is an historic listed building we would not accept UPVC units. The doors should therefore either be in metal (usually powder coated aluminium) or timber. Once you have submitted revised details we will then set up a discharge of condition application as all details have to be formally discharge with a decision notice. Do ring if you need to discuss.
