

When held by a public body (as defined separately by the FoIA and EIR), the data will still be subject to FoIA and EIR, but proper regard must be given to its level of sensitivity in assessing whether to release this data in response to a request under that legislation in a public interest test.

General Terms of Data Release

- 3. Registered 'data users' must not pass on or share their Aderyn User Name or Password with any other person.
- 4. Data supplied by LERC Wales ('the data') and any online access to data, e.g. through Aderyn or eMapper Link, as well as any derivative of 'the data', such as downloads, electronic and paper tables and maps, can be accessed only by those specified as registered 'Data Users' in the data request and that they have received a copy of these 'Terms and Conditions'.
- 5. The 'Data User' cannot pass 'the data' onto any unspecified third parties without the permission of the relevant LERC.
- 6. The 'Data User' may not copy, distribute, disseminate, publish or broadcast 'the data' in any format, including on the Internet, without the permission of the relevant LERC.
- 7. I agree that where other parties require access to 'the data', I will direct them to the relevant LERC.
- 8. 'The data' must not be entered into a computerised database or Geographic Information System (GIS) for a period longer than 12 months, unless otherwise specified by the relevant LERC.
- 9. 'The data' should be kept secure from unauthorised or accidental use, access, disclosure or loss, and all reasonable practical steps taken to ensure the security of 'the data'.
- 10. The 'Data User' cannot use 'the data' for any purpose other than that for which it was requested.
- 11. Permission to use 'the data' expires 12 months from when 'the data' was produced, the 'Search Date'.
- 12. 'The data' should be deleted or destroyed within 12 months. Contact the relevant LERC within one month of 'Expiry date' if access to 'the data' is still required.
- 13. 'The data' requested should be used for legitimate and legal purposes.
- 14. The 'Data User' nor anyone else specified in 'the data' request, should have been investigated for or convicted of any form of wildlife crime.
- 15. No 'Data User' should have previously misused data obtained from other LERCs.
- 16. The copyright of raw biological records remains with the original recorder and that copyright of processed data and reports belongs to the relevant LERC.
- 17. The 'Data User' will not hold the LERC or its data suppliers liable for problems and/or financial loss, which might arise from inaccuracy of any data supplied by LERC Wales.
- 18. Please acknowledge the relevant LERC in any publication or report produced using data it has supplied. A copy should be supplied at no charge to the relevant LERC where appropriate.
