The new owner of Spooner lodge would like to remove T1 Walnut. A rear extension is planned in the near future. T2 is touching the neighbours listed barn. We are concerned about the root penetration under the barn as well as the touching branches with potential for damage. Removal is preferred.

T3 is a tall conifer which blocks and divides to the rear garden in two. Removal is preferred

T4 & T5 are silver birch trees which we feel are to tall and close to the neighbours garage. Removal is preferred.

The new owner would like to reinstate the garden and plant trees in more suitable locations with out the fear of falling trees onto neighbours property.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
