These two Yews have been pruned hard to the boundary leaving an asymmetrical shape. Cut both to hedge height and maintain as part of existing Yew hedge. T4 and T5. T. x europaea and J. nigra. Both in car park area. Lift canopy by removing lower limbs to allow a 3m clearance for high vehicles.
