Overgrown Yew Tree Hedge 1 to be reduced in height to match the height of the leylandii hedge. Overgrown Yew Tree 2 to be reduced in height to 10ft
Overgrown Conifer 3 and 4 to be reduced in height as shown in photo: conifers 3 & 4
Tree work will tidy and re- shape the overgrown boundary hedge and also take branches that are endangering the telephone lines.
