Identification of Tree(s) and Description of Works

Please identify the tree(s) and provide a full and clear specification of the works you want to carry out

Further to planning request 22/04137/PRUTPO application T7 has been identified as a hazel tree. As per planning application 22/04137/PRUTPO I request permission to remove the large overhanging branch and overgrowth extending over garden area at approximately 1.5 metres height extending towards kitchen of property. The removal is up to the boundary fence of 28 Tynedale Gardens and no further, the main trunk being within the grounds of 28 Tynedale Gardens. Note the removal action requested is the same as for planning application ref 22/04137/PRUTPO with the tree now correctly identified.

For oak trees at T4, T5 and T6, entirely within the property of 35 Birkdene, permission is requested to reduce the crown for each tree by 3 metres on the advice of a professional arborologist, to reduce the weight of branches/growth and minimise further risks of large branches breaking/snapping and to protect the overall integrity of the tree. This request is in addition to that within planning application ref 22/04137/PRUTPO for the removal of dead and dangerous branches (see photographs provided with this and previous application).

All other agreed action within planning application 22/04137/PRUTPO is to continue unamended.

Below is summary of recommended tree works:

- 27/02/2023 Tree ServiRemove Hazel tree back to boundary fence.
- 27/02/2023 Tree ServiOption 2 - Crown reduce by 3m 20.0% S largest Oak tree and deadwood.
- 27/02/2023 Tree ServiCrown reduce by 3m medium Oak 20.0% S tree and deadwood.
- 27/02/2023 Tree ServiCrown reduce by 3m and deadwood 20.0% S smaller Oak tree.

- if there are many trees on the site, make clear which tree(s) are included in this application by:
 - marking all trees on the plan, but only numbering those to which you want to carry out work
 - showing the approximate distance between the application tree(s) and buildings
 - adding other relevant features on the site (e.g. greenhouse, paths)
