All new trees to be supported with stakes. All stakes should penetrate the soil to at least 60cm (2ft) deep. If the stake moves in the ground, it will not anchor the plant. The stakes should be one-third of the height of the tree.  
Stakes should be inserted on the side of the prevailing wind so that the tree is blown away from the stake.  
Attach the trees to the stakes with tree straps, with buckles for fastening and adjustment.  
Use spacers to prevent the stem and stake rubbing against each other.
