The main features of the outside of the property include:

Entrance Front: two (2) storeys, five (5) broad bays. The centre and outer bays break forward slightly. The centre bay is represented by a large lonic porte-cochere, with two (2) columns in antis, set against a loggia of three (3) pairs of lonic columns, which span the centre of the three (3) bays, lead to the outer hall. The entire front has banded rustication that breaks to form voussoirs over the ground floor openings. Twelve- (12-) and six- (6-) pane sashes. Cornice and parapet with panels carved with scrolls, palmettes and anthemia. Hipped roof.

Garden Front: three (3) storeys, six (6) bay centre, with projecting two (2) storey one-bay wings. The centre has similar banded rustication which is echoed in the angle pilasters of the wings. Single-storey loggia of four (4) lonic columns in antis. Full-length twelve- (12-) pane sashes on the ground floor. Wood cross windows on the 1st floor and six- (6-) pane sashes above. 2nd floor sill string, palmette frieze, dentil cornice and panelled parapet with scrolls. Projecting wings have full-length tripartite windows on the ground floor and shorter tripartite windows above. Parapets with scrolls and palmettes.

South Front: large two (2) storey, three (3) bay bow window.
