

### Main House - Ground Floor - Fire Escape Plan

Windows can be opened to provide safe and easy access to the garden

During the last 46 years, both the Main House and Service Wing have been used as an independent residential school for Dyslexia, which was closed last year (2022). As such, the property has a comprehensive, up-to-date, and fully operational fire alarm system that was installed and is still monitored by Churches Fire. The property includes the fire alarms themselves, emergency lighting throughout the building, and fire extinguishers.

When the fire alarm is activated, an alert is immediately sent to the alarm receiving centre, which notifies the local fire and rescue services and nominated key holders.
