Identification of Tree(s) and Description of Works

T1- Sycamore situated in the rear garden of the property. The applicant is requesting a 4 metre height reduction to this tree. The tree itself is situated 2 feet (see pic) from a Jacobean wall and approximately 3 meters from other listed buildings. The tree itself is on a lean in the direction of number 17 & 17a Bailffgate both of which are listed buildings. The crown of the tree overhangs these properties. The tree causes excessive shade. Leaf debris falls onto the roofs of the other properties blocking guttering, this requires annual maintenance. The tree also causes excessive shade to other properties. Owners of these properties have complained about all these issues.

T2- Ash Tree also situated in the rear garden of the applicants home and on the opposite side to the above sycamore tree. The applicant is requesting lower branches be removed to this tree as they are substantially overhanging the neighbours garden at number 13 Bailiffgate. The applcant is also requesting a 4 metre crown reduction to this tree as well as crown thinning of dead wood. There is evidence of die back within the crown. The tree also causes excessive shade to the applicants garden and home.

In support of the application Sycamore trees planted some years ago and situated along the main street of Bailiffgate are also in the conservation area, these are directly outside the applicants address and were subject to a crown reduction of 50%. These have now re grown back substantially .
