## Method of Work

While on site all operatives will wear PPE consisting of safety helmets, safety boots, hi-vis jackets, with glasses, ear defenders and gloves when required. Ear protection must **always** be used in noisy conditions or when using tools/machinery.

COVID-19 regulations are to be adhered to at all times

The fencing and welfare unit will be delivered to site

Operatives will erect the fencing where required to secure the site.

The work involved in this safe system is to strip out all the buildings, including outbuildings and kennels prior to machine demolition

All services are to be disconnected by others, prior to any stripping out and demolition taking place.

- 1. All operatives to site will receive an induction on their initial visit.
- 2. Once this is complete, soft strip will commence
- 3. Skips will be brought to site and located to the rear of the property
- 4. Operatives will soft strip the property
- 5. All timber doors, skirtings, architraves, partitions, worktops, floorboards, etc are to be removed and placed into the timber skip for removal for recycling.
- 6. Any metal work such a pipes, radiators etc, are to be removed and placed in the metal skip for recycling.
- 7. Any wires or cabling are to be separated and removed for recycling.
- 8. All the other debris is to be removed and placed into the general waste skip for removal from site
- 9. The outbuildings are to be stripped out and kennels dismantled

All work will be undertaken by qualified competent persons with experience of the type of work described above, and in all cases, in full accordance with safety procedures specified in the company's Health and Safety Policy.
