

TYPICAL PLANTING SCHEDULE

INDIVIDUAL NATIVE TREES

- Alder glutinosa - alder,
- Betula pendula - silver birch,
- Prunus avium - wild cherry,
- Sorbus aria - whitebeam,
- Tilia cordata - small leaved lime

NATIVE HEDGE PLANTING

- Primary 50% - Crataegus monogyna, Hawthorn
- Secondary 25% - Prunus spinosa, Blackthorn
- Occasional 25%: Cornus sanguinea - common dogwood, Corylus avellana - hazel, Frangula alnus - alder buckthorn, Ilex aquifolium - holly, Rosa canina - dog rose, Viburnum lantana - wayfaring tree, Viburnum opulus - guelder rose.

Note: Hedges to consist of transplants set out in two staggered rows with 7 plants per linear meter and groups of 3 to 7 plants of one species. Native hedges located along part of the northern and southern boundaries are to include a mixture of individual native tree species from the list of native trees above. Individual native tree species are to be planted at random within the hedges. No individual native trees are located within the Native hedges between the lodges.

NATIVE TREES AND SHRUBS

- Acer campestre - field maple,
- Cornus sanguinea - dogwood,
- Corylus avellana - hazel,
- Crataegus monogyna - hawthorn,
- Frangula alnus - alder buckthorn,
- Ilex aquifolium - holly,
- Populus tremula - aspen,
- Prunus avium - wild cherry
- Quercus robur - common oak,
- Salix fragilis - crack willow,
- Tilia cordata - small-leaved lime,
- Viburnum opulus - guelder rose.

Note: To be planted at 1-meter spacings in single species groupings of 3 to 5 plants.

NATIVE SCRUB

- Corylus avellana - hazel,
- Crataegus monogyna - hawthorn,
- Prunus spinosa - blackthorn,
- Rosa canina - dog rose,
- Ulex europaeus - common gorse

Note: Native scrub to be located adjacent to the turning heads. To be planted at 1-meter spacings in single species groupings of 3 to 7 plants.

ORNAMENTAL PLANTING

- Cistus x cyprius - Common gum cistus,
- Euonymus japonicus 'Microphyllus' - Japanese spindle,
- Hebe 'Red Edge' - hebe 'Red Edge',
- Lavandula angustifolia 'Hidcote' - English lavender,
- Lonicera ligustrina var. pileate - box-leaved honeysuckle
- Pervskia atriplicifolia - Russian sage,
- Pittosporum tenuifolium 'Variegatum' - pittosporum (specimen shrub)

Note: Ornamental planting to be located at internal points within the Park.

WETLAND PLANTING

- Caltha palustris - marsh marigold,
- Carex acutiformis - lesser pond sedge,
- Filipendula ulmaria - meadow sweet, Iris pseudacorus - yellow flag,
- Juncus acutiflorus - sharp-flowering rush,
- Lythrum salicaria - purple loosestrife

Note: Wetland planting to be planted in informal swathes at 5/m2.

AQUATIC SPECIMEN PLANTING

- Nymphaea alba - lily,
- Ranunculus aquatilis - water crowfoot

POND MARGINS

Very Wetland meadow - Wildflower Turf /
Mix EG8 - 'Meadow Grass Mixture for Wet Soils' by Emorsgate (or similar and approved)

WILDFLOWER GRASSLAND

EM7 Meadow Mixture to include the following additional species within the mix:

- Armeria maritima - thrift,
- Silene uniflora - sea campion,
- Beta vulgaris maritima - sea beet,
- Eryngium maritimum - sea holly,
- Ranunculus bulbosus - bulbous buttercup,
- Leucanthemum vulgare - oxeye daisy.

Note: Mix to consist of 30% wildflower species and 70% grass species.

AMENITY GRASSLAND
