

## NOTES ON PLANTING DEPTHS & ANTICIPATED ROOTING DEPTHS:

The tree planting proposals are shown on  $\boldsymbol{\mathsf{MLLA}}$ Landscape Masterplan Drawing PR209-01 Rev V which is available under separate cover and of which this drawing is an excerpt. It is proposed to plant 7 No. upright form Silver Birch trees (Betula Pendula 'Obelisk' within the southern edge of the Heritage Assets Site. These trees will be planted within 1.0m deep tree pits. The details and dimensions of Tree Pit Detail B are shown on MLLA Drawing PR209-12 which is also available under separate cover. It is also proposed to plant a new section of native species hedgerow, within and close to the southern edge of the Heritage Asset  $\,$ Site. This hedgerow will comprise of a mix of eight different native species as set out on MLLA POS Planting Proposals Drawing PR209-04 Rev D which is available under separate cover. Cultivation for the hedge planting trench will only be to a depth of

It is anticipated that all of the trees and hedgerow species will prefer to root fairly close to the surface and it is generally understood that trees will have the vast majority of their roots within the top 600mm below ground level (which generally corresponds to where moisture and oxygen can most easily be found).

It is understood that there is approximately 1.2m depth of soils overlaid on top of the upper edge of the existing archaeological feature. It is not considered that the long-term rooting of the new trees and hedgerows that are proposed will disturb any in-situ archaeology.
