T6 - twin-stemmed mature Ash. North-side stem monolithed at 10 m due to basal fungal decay. South-side stem in good condition. Fell north side stem to 1 m high.

T10 - Mature Lime in significant decline due to dieback in upper crown. Remove top 4m of dead wood.
