This is a large cedar tree that stands in the middle of the Doddington Hall Gardens, it is in a relativily open space near the Temple of the Winds.  We have consulted with Atkinson ARB tree specialists, who have done work previously in our gardens, they suggest that due to the dry summer last year and the currant dry spell the tree is more likely to shed limbs - the tree has previously done this. This tree is in a Garden open regularly to the public and therefore we feel this is a potential H&S risk.  Atkinson ARB have suggested trimming the tree as shown in the photos attached.
