

Elm Lodge Road, Laxfield. IP13 8ET.

T1 – Field Maple, Height 12m, DBH 510mm, crown spread 4m.

T2 – Ash, Height 18m, DBH 420mm & 420mm, crown spread 6m.

T3 – Ash, Height 18m, DBH 380mm & 380mm, crown spread 6m.

Both Ash trees bifurcate @ 1m thus 2 DBH per tree.

- All 3 trees are located on a narrow section of land between Elm Lodge Road and the neighbouring back garden boundary fences. The section of land is jointly owned by the residents of Elm lodge Road. This application is on behalf of all residents.
- The trees are in good health with good vitality, which has landscape value to the wider area.
- The trees have Elm Lodge Road, which is the access to 4 properties, to the north and neighbouring back gardens to the south. The trees are overhanging both the back gardens, car park and the road. The overhang on the roadside is beginning to be damaged by high sided deliver vehicles.
- The residents and the neighbours would benefit from the trees being reduced by approximately 30%, if done within the guidelines of BS3998 in the dormant season, the trees would have the best possible chance of responding well to the pruning.
