We will need to receive a response to any extension of time promptly, and in writing (by email).

If agreement is not reached, the application may be determined within the statutory time period, which could result in permission being refused using delegated powers on the grounds that insufficient information has been provided.

If by you have not been told that your fee cheque has been dishonoured or you have not agreed in writing to extend the period in which the decision may be given, the person who made the application could submit an appeal to the Planning Inspectorate under Section 195 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.
