

Proposed work to render the brick exterior of Bradgate House, Hunston

The house is currently 1950's brick. When the house was originally built in the 1950s there was open field between it and Hunston village so its brick construction was not such an evident contrast with the houses and cottages in the village. However, with the later construction of Ash House (which is rendered) Bradgate House became the first house in the village rather than an 'outlier'. The vast majority of housing in Hunston (both old and new) is rendered either with traditional lime mortar or more modern renders in the case of newer homes (we believe there is only one other brick house within the village) so although outside the conservation boundary of the village we would like to bring the house more into keeping with the rest of the village.
