The land was formally associated with the Hendra Court Nursing Care Home, but is now under separate ownership. There are established hedgerows along the boundaries and a small area used for hard-surfacing for parking. There are some trees to the south of the parcel of land, subject to a blanket TPO, and any future proposal will need to consider these.

Site Area (hectares):

If you propose to attach any supporting information relating to known or likely constraints on the site please briefly describe what information you intend to provide.

There is a Tree Preservation Order (Killhallon Par Cornwall) on land around the Care Home and its driveway. In recognition of this constraint, the application has excluded a large section of the TPO area as it is recognised that residential development could affect the protected trees. The site is adjacent to Killhallon, Par, with development to the East (Care Home) and residential properties to the North. Policy H1 of the NDP allows affordable housing led development which meets a local need. A technical consent will be required to demonstrate that a residential development can meet all the technical requirements.
