It is proposed to remove the early 20th century milking shed whilst retaining the lower part of the W wall which is a 19th century red brick farmyard wall, raised in height with fletton brick courses. The building has no significant historic fabric apart from the lower part of the W wall and is of low overall significance.

It is also proposed to remove building G (HIA), identified in the Building Record as an early 19th century, single storey vehicle shed, from the E elevation of the barn. The building is of low significance

Why is it necessary to demolish or extend (as applicable) all or part of the building(s) and or structure(s)?

removal of building G will fully expose the E elevation of the main barn A and the 3 ventilation slits. The removal of the early 20th century milking shed will reveal further reveal the N elevation of the barn as it existed in the early 19th century including the brick buttresses, enhancing the view looking South
