- 1. No change to exisJ ng cog age proposal, intent is to open the ceiling void above the bedroom (Eastern half) but will be ensuring access beneath J les as per your suggested detail
- 2. Extension to the east has changed quite significantly, becoming less verJ cally-orientated, stepping down the hill further
- 3. The roof height generally is lower than exisJ ng in this area, but we will be insJ gaJ ng bat boxes to the North side at proposed roof level height (assuming exact details on this can be resolved with you in due course ai er planning achieved)
